The Draft Land Use Plan and Regulations take into consideration public input received following similar sessions held in April, 2011 to review the Draft Comprehensive Land Use Plan.

The agenda for both workshops includes a presentation of the Draft Plan, and the land use controls proposed to implement it, followed by a discussion session where you will have the opportunity ask questions, give your ideas and opinions and hear about the next steps. To make it more convenient for those wanting to attend, the workshop will be held at two different times and locations.
