

History of Pulaski County Notice and Meetings on the Regulations in the Lake Maumelle Watershed (9/1/11)

- + **2004** CAW began the Task Group for Watershed Management
- + **2007** CAW adopts the Watershed Management Plan
- + **Summer, 2007** Planning Staff began writing and editing the subdivision ordinance
- + **January, 2008** 120 day Moratorium on Lake Maumelle Watershed development adopted
- + **March, 2008** Public Hearing held by the county (Press Release issued)
- + **April, 2008** Public Hearing held by the county (Press Release issued)
- + **April, May, and June 2008** Watershed is discussed at the Planning Board Public hearing
(Press Release issued)
- + **June, 2008** Planning Board unanimously adopts resolutions recommending approval of the proposed ordinances (including Chapter 8, Watershed Regulations)
- + **March, 2009** Central Arkansas Water held a public hearing and voted to support the county's proposed subdivision ordinance
- + **April, 2009** Quorum Court holds a public hearing on the Subdivision Regulations and votes to adopt them.
- + **May, 2009** **Pulaski County Public Works mailed an informational letter to all property owners in the Watershed informing them of the new Subdivision Regulations and the upcoming work on land use regulations.**
- + **October, 2009** Wallace Roberts & Todd (WRT) begin the land use study with a "charrette" which included data collection and the review stakeholder meetings
- + **May, 2010** Pulaski County Planning Board holds a public hearing on the Stormwater Management and Drainage Manual and Site Evaluation Tool (SET) for the Lake Maumelle Watershed (Press Release issued and notice published in the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette)

+June, 2010 Quorum Court adopts the Stormwater Management and Drainage Manual and Site Evaluation Tool (SET) for the Lake Maumelle Watershed

+ February, 2010 Project Kickoff (WRT Lake Maumelle Watershed Land Use Plan)

+July, 2010 Preliminary Land Use Concept Alternatives (First Draft) presented in a public workshop (press release issued and email blast sent from Planning's collected database, Stakeholder Sessions scheduled the day following public workshop)

+ September, 2010 Preliminary Land Use Concept Alternatives (Second Draft) presented in two public workshops (press release issued and email blast sent from Planning's collected database Stakeholder Sessions scheduled the day following public workshop)

+December, 2010 Recommended Land Use Concept presented in two public workshops (press release issued and email blast sent from Planning's collected database, Stakeholder Sessions scheduled the day following the public workshops)

+February, 2011 Comprehensive Land Use Plan (First Draft) presented in two public workshops (press release issued and email blast sent from Planning's collected database, fliers posted in the Watershed in Pulaski public places such as churches, fire stations, etc., Stakeholder Sessions scheduled the day following the public workshops)

+April, 2011 Comprehensive Land Use Plan (Final Draft) presented in two public workshops (press release issued and email blast sent from Planning's collected database, fliers posted in the Watershed in Pulaski public places such as churches, fire stations, etc., Stakeholder Sessions scheduled the day following the public workshops)

+August, 2011 Draft Land Use Controls and Ordinance presented in two public workshops (press release issued and email blast sent from Planning's collected database, fliers posted in the Watershed in Pulaski public places such as churches, fire stations, etc., Stakeholder Sessions scheduled the day following the public workshops)

++ September 27, 2011 The Pulaski County Planning Board held a Public hearing on the Land Use Plan and Regulations (press release was issued, email blast sent from Planning's collected database, FAQ list mailed to all the property owners in the Watershed and two notices published in the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette)
